## About the hotfix

This release focuses on a request put forth by a number of customers. It has been reported that on some occasions customers have found multiple address books and calendars on the device.

## Functional Changes

This section lists the functional changes included in the hotfix for BlackBerry® Device Software versions 4.5 to 5.0.

Change	Description
<b>Remove duplicate instances of the address book</b>	<p>The tool will run automatically after being pushed to the device and will check for the custom IT policy (for example, "ADDRESSBOOK_MERGE_TOOL_ALLOWED_EXEC"). The tool will identify the actively syncing DESKTOP address book and then make that address book the default address book. The tool will then remove any duplicate address book entries if they are not from a BIS address book. If a duplicate entry is from a BIS address book, the tool will not remove it. Once complete, the tool will schedule itself for deletion.</p> <p>Note: The custom IT policy must be a boolean and set to True. The IT policy must be applied to the device before the tool is pushed to the device.</p>
<b>Remove duplicate instances of the calendar</b>	<p>The tool will run automatically after being pushed to the device and will check for the custom IT policy (for example, "CALENDAR_MERGE_TOOL_ALLOWED_EXEC" is set to true. When this IT policy is enabled, the tool will disable wireless sync on calendar and then remove all calendar entries from the device, and then re-enable wireless sync. The Calendar application will sync the calendar entries from the server. Once complete, the tool will schedule itself for deletion.</p>

**Note:** If your device uses BlackBerry Device Software version 4.5-4.7, the Duplicate Address Book Removal Tool will drop any orphaned group address book entries. This known issue does not apply to devices that use BlackBerry Device Software version 5.0 or higher.

There have been no changes to the radio or OS components. These components are identical in this hotfix release and in the BlackBerry Device Software for devices that are currently being shipped.
